MARITIME SECURITY LEVELS DEFINED

1.0 Introduction

The Maritime Security Act 2004 defines Security Level as:

"the quantification of the degree of risk that a security incident will be attempted or will occur"

2.0 Levels defined

- **Level 1**
means the level for which minimum appropriate protective security measures must be maintained at all times Security
- **Level 2**
means the level for which appropriate additional protective security measures must be maintained for a period of time as a result of heightened risk of security incident. Security
- **Level 3**
means the level for which further specific protective security measures must be maintained for a limited period of time when a security incident is probable or imminent, although it may not be possible to identify the specific target.
