NOTES FOR COMPLETION OF BUILDER'S CERTIFICATE FORM SR23

1. Show the year in which the ship was fully completed or, where the ship has been built in stages by different builders, the year of completion of the stage of construction.
2. Where the ship has been built in stages by different builders, a separate builder's certificate for each stage of building is required. The certificate must show the extent of the builder's involvement, eg hull only.
3. Show owner's place of residence. Postal box numbers and care of the vessel are not acceptable. For a Body Corporate incorporated in New Zealand, show its registered office which must be the address recorded at the Companies Office.
4. The ship must be described in technical terms. If in doubt about the correct term to use, technical advice should be sought. Following are examples of descriptive particulars:
 - Type of Ship Pleasure, Fishing Vessel, Passenger, Charter, Cargo, Tanker, Bulk Carrier.
 - Type of rigging Sloop, Cutter, Ketch, Schooner, Yawl. If the ship is not rigged, show "not rigged".
 - Type of Stem Raked, Clipper, Plumb, Raked/Bulbous.
 - Type of Stern Transom, Cruiser, Counter.
 - Build description Carvel (flush planking) or Clinker (edge lapped planking) for wood, fibre reinforced plastic and ferrocement hulls; Welded or Riveted for metal hulls.
5. The builder must sign and date the builder's certificate. If the builder is a partnership or firm, one of the partners must sign stating "AB, a partner for AB and CD partnership".
6. Where the builder is a Body Corporate, refer to form SR30 for methods of executing documents on behalf of a Body Corporate.

METHODS OF EXECUTION BY A COMPANY ACCEPTABLE TO THE REGISTRAR OF SHIPS – SR30

Notes

- (i) The appropriate method of execution may depend upon the provisions of the company's constitution. If you are in any doubt about how your company executes documents, you should seek advice from your solicitor.
- (ii) Methods 2, 3, 4 and 5 require witnesses. Any witness will be acceptable provided that:
 - The person executing is personally known to the witness;
 - The witness is not a co-signatory or a party to the transaction.
- (iii) All persons signing must print their full name and description after their signature.
- (iv) All witnesses must print their full name, address and occupation after their signature.
