Explanatory notes

1. The information provided on this form is used to update your vessel's status in Maritime New Zealand's operator/vessel database.

Notes 2 and 3 apply to MOSS operators only

2. When completed, this form meets the requirement for a maritime transport operator to notify the Director when a vessel exits its maritime operation as required under Maritime Rules Part 19. If this is the only change, there is no requirement to complete the *Notification of update to an operator plan* form.
3. If you are no longer a maritime transport operator and wish to permanently exit MOSS, please courier or post the original of your Maritime Transport Operator Certificate along with this form to Operator Certification.
