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NOTES FOR COMPLETION OF DECLARATION FOR ABSENCE OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS

This form is applicable only for the initial registration of ships in Part A of the Register. It cannot be used for ships already registered in Part A

For a body corporate incorporated in New Zealand, show its registered office which must be the address recorded at the Companies Office. For any other Body Corporate, show its principal place of business in New Zealand or, if none, its registered office in its country of incorporation.

Notes

 - The person executing is personally known to the witness;
 - The witness is not a co-signatory or a party to the transaction.
